# Title: Senior Maintenance Mechanic-HVAC

FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

#### **BRIEF DESCRIPTION:**

The purpose of this position is to perform general HVAC maintenance (including P-TAC units, high-rise chillers and boiliers) on Housing Authority property and ensure a safe and clean environment for all tenants and personnel. This is accomplished by responding to maintenance work orders, processing paperwork including work order requests, submitting requests for supplies as needed, performing preventative maintenance on equipment and property, and ensuring dispatch is aware of location at all times. Other duties include performing special projects as requested and assisting other personnel and teams with maintenance duties.
